

Annual Report SDG16 Piece and Justice (updates 2023 vs. 2022)

In the year 2022/2023, BUC has taken many positive steps to achieve progress in SDG 16 (piece and Justice)

– **BUC University as a body ensures that local stakeholders in the university, including local residents, local government, and civil society representatives (which may include groups such as refugee resettlement agencies), have a meaningful mechanism for participating in university decision making which is included in the BUC strategic plan 2019-2024 through the following procedures**

1- BUC University representatives in Supreme Council of Universities and Ministry of Higher Education, identify society requirements and market needs

- a) **The decision of launching AI program in School of Business**
- b) **The decision of BUC president to open the door for registration of refugees from Ukraine, Russia and Sudan during the war political circumstances**
- c) **Joint cooperation between BUC and civil society representatives (Egyptian Red Crescent)**

In view of the pioneering role played by the Egyptian Red Crescent Society, which is based on volunteer efforts to develop society through its volunteer-based programs, especially among the youth, and because of the university's role in developing community and volunteer awareness, Badr University and the Egyptian Red Crescent Society decided to develop a protocol for cooperation between them as a goal.

d) Joint collaboration between Badr University in Cairo and civil society representatives (Egyptian Cervical Endoscopy Association)

2- The strategic plan of the Government “Ministry of Health and Population” to apply 100 Million Health campaign had a role in BUC decisions regarding the nature of workshops and awareness campaigns held by staff and students

- A) **Workshops: Principles, updates and pitfalls in pap smear interpretation**
- B) **Early Breast Cancer detection campaign held by School of Medicine in collaboration with school of Nursing**

3- To validate the university policy against corruption and bribery, The Student Training Unit at the Faculty of Law at Badr University in Cairo organized summer training for students transferred to the fourth level who are assigned to perform summer training, in cooperation with the Egyptian Judicial Foundation represented by the “Suez Court of First Instance.”

4- Provision of Health Quality and Accreditation Diploma

5- Sharing in many research fields with the government and Academy of Scientific Research and Technology

6- Provision of neutral platform for policy makers to discuss challenges and take decision through international conferences in fields of Medicine, economy, climate, refugees
