In the year 2023/2024, BUC has taken many positive steps to achieve progress in SDG 3 (Health and Wellbeing):

Local and national Collaborations

- Memorandum of understanding between School of Medicine BUC and Faculty of Medicine Ain Shams University

In the framework of supporting scientific and academic cooperation between Egyptian public universities and private universities, Prof. Dr. Mohamed Diao Zein El-Abidin, President of Ain Shams University, and Prof. Dr. Ashraf Mohamed El-Shihi, President of Badr University in Cairo, signed a memorandum of understanding between the two universities, with the aim of developing academic cooperation and enhancing mutual understanding between the two parties.

- Collaboration between Badr University and Egyptian Red Crescent:

The Egyptian Red Crescent Unit at Badr University in Cairo has implemented the "First Aid" training, Within the framework of preparing Volunteers to play a pioneering role in the field of health, relief, disasters and crises and to help their fellow students when any possible injuries occur in different situations

International Collaborations

- Badr University signs a memorandum of understanding with the medical sector at Peking University:

Peking University had previously participated in organizing the International Forum for Academic Relations with Badr University in November 2023 to celebrate the 10th anniversary of the Belt and Road Initiative. Afterwards, a high-level delegation from the Chinese university visited Badr University, attended by the deans of the medical colleges at Badr University. The two parties discussed areas and means of cooperation, which bore fruit through an intensive training camp for eight students from the Faculty of Dentistry at Badr University, which included training on the latest artificial intelligence technologies in the dental laboratories of the Faculty of Dentistry at Peking University. The two parties also discussed opportunities for scholarships and camps, in addition to exchanging professors and visiting professors.

- Collaboration between Badr University and Lincoln University (Malaysia)

Badr University is proud to announce its collaboration with Lincoln University Malaysia, providing an exceptional opportunity for students who wish to enroll in the Bachelor of Medicine program. This partnership ensures that students receive a world-class education, combining Badr University's renowned teaching with Lincoln University's innovative curriculum.

By joining this program, students will enjoy unparalleled academic excellence, hands-on training, and the opportunity to be part of a prestigious medical community. Through this unique collaboration, aspiring doctors will be equipped with the skills and knowledge to excel in the medical field.

- Memorandum of understanding between Badr University and University of Canterbury, UK

The memorandum includes "community development programmes, student and researcher exchange, scholarships, and cooperation in the field of scientific research, including participation in scientific conferences and seminars, joint research projects, and industrial cooperation with international companies in Britain." This allows graduates to obtain a university completion certificate from Canterbury Christ Church University, as well as cooperation in the field of teacher training and qualifying them to obtain the Internationally Qualified Teacher Certificate "IQTS" granted by the British government. Dr. Ashraf Al-Shihi noted that the university campus of Badr University in Cairo includes the "Continuing Education Center", which allows students to raise their proficiency in more than (12) international languages, especially English; as required by some college courses within the university campus, especially the colleges of the medical and engineering sciences sector.

Volunteering and health outreach programs:

Including student volunteering and field visits to Baheya foundation of breast cancer and Children Cancer Hospital foundation 57357, breast cancer awareness program, Health outreach program provided by School of Nursing BUC to provide complete health care services and health awareness to geriatrics in geriatric centers.

Community Services

The role of School of Medicine BUC and Badr foundation for community development to supervise and lead the mission of providing health care service in Badr and Shorouk Medical center run by professional staff members and physicians working at BUC faculty of medicine. Clinics for all disciplines are available including family planning and nutrition and sexual health clinics

Care of sexual and reproductive health

Continuous care is provided through health care clinics in Badr and Shorouk centers related to Badr foundation of community development. Sexual and reproductive healthcare awareness was provided in many sessions in first annual "Family Medicine" Conference held by school of Medicine, BUC.
